CLUSTER MEETINGS

BUS TRANSPORTATION

Bus transportation is provided for *sixth grade* students living further than .8 miles from the school and *seventh and eighth grade* students living further than 1.3 miles from the school. *A bus pass is necessary.*

Sixth grade students who are eligible for transportation *will receive a bus pass in the mail during the month of August*. Consult the August issue of "Your Schools" on the District website @ rvcschools.org for the closest bus stop and pick up time.

Late buses are available to eligible bus riders each day at 3:40 PM, and 5:00 PM. These buses do an <u>all district</u> route and <u>do not</u> stop at all of the regular stops for each bus route.
