Person will go into immediate withdrawal and will become violent. Presentation assistants were recovering heroin addicts. (R. Cammarata) SSMS doesn't have a Narcan kit on site. Matt Ballace spoke last week. Dr. Leahy spoke of her family; military, professionals and 1 heroin addict. Can't just say no to drugs; have to yes to other things to stay drug free. M. Ballace told kids to find a natural high. As parents we have to pressure the medical community to take care with prescriptions. LI heroin addiction is at epidemic propositions. Room at presentation wasn't packed because 7th & 8th grade got extra credit last year and this year extra credit was for PE or Health. (J. Pascarella) hard to get message through the undeveloped teenage brain, have to be constant. Jewell's are small cigarettes with high amounts of nicotine.
